## Encl 1. Contest Mechanics and Criteria

## **General Contest Mechanics:**

- 1. Each district will have one participant and coach.
- 2. The contestant shall be in his/her school uniform.
- 3. All coaches will not be permitted to get inside the contest venue during the competition proper.
- 4. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
