1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum 634, s. 2025 titled "**Implementation of School-Based Immunization 2025**", this Office supports the Department of Education (DepEd) Region X and the Department of Health's initiatives, in preparation for the School-Based Immunization 2025 implementation.
2. The School-Based Immunization (SBI) aims to protect the school-aged children against vaccine-preventable diseases. This program improves the health and well-being of school-aged children by lowering the risk for Grade 1 and Grade 7 learners against measles and rubella and Grade 4 female learners against Human Papillomavirus (HPV).
3. The following approved activities shall be conducted in schools, effective upon the release of this Memo:
 - a. Master List of Grade 1, Grade 4, and Grade 7 learners for the school-based immunization program using the link <https://tinyurl.com/SBIReporting>;
 - b. Inclusion of immunization information and advocacy in key school events such as Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) meetings and Brigada Eskwela activities;
 - c. Initiation of collaborative meetings with Local Government Units (LGUs) and DepEd for the preparatory phase of implementation; and
 - d. Facilitation and scheduling of immunization sessions within schools, in coordination with school heads, to allow the health workers to administer vaccines to the identified eligible population;

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
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1. The Department of Health (DOH), in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepEd) Region X, will be implementing the **2025 School Based Immunization 2025** with the attached Revised Guidelines.
2. The SBI aims to protect school-aged children against vaccine preventable diseases. This program improves the health and well-being of school-aged children by lowering the risk for Grade 1 and Grade 7 learners against measles and rubella and Grade 4 learners against Human Papilloma Virus (HPV).
3. The following approved activities shall be conducted in schools:
 - a. Master List of Grade 1, Grade 4, and Grade 7 learners for the school-based immunization program using the link <https://tinyurl.com/SBIReporting>;
 - b. Inclusion of immunization information and advocacy in key school events such as Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) meetings and Brigada Eskwela activities;
 - c. Initiation of collaborative meetings with Local Government Units (LGUs) and DepEd for the preparatory phase of implementation; and
 - d. Facilitation and scheduling of immunization sessions within schools, in coordination with school heads, to allow the health workers to administer vaccines to the identified eligible population:
 - i. Designate Fridays as school vaccination days to minimize disruption to regular classes.
 - ii. Health workers to begin administering vaccines as early as September 2025, subject to vaccine availability, or later based on the consent of parents or caregivers.
