2022 NATIONAL OBSERVANCE OF THE FILIPINO VALUES MONTH

- 1. With reference to DepEd Memorandum No. 101, s. 2022 re: 2022 National Observance of the Filipino Values Month, this Office hereby informs the field that all schools and learning centers are enjoined to conduct activities in celebration of the 2022 National Observance of the Filipino Values Month with the theme, "Magagandang Kaugaliang Pilipino: Isabuhay at Pagyamanin Tungo sa Matiwasay at Maunlad na Kinabukasan."
- 2. This year's theme focuses on how Filipino values can be strengthened and exercised in the life of each Filipino that can contribute to nation-building and achievement of individual and national goals.
- 3. During the month-long observance, all schools are encouraged to integrate the Filipino values in the teaching-Jearning activities, not only in the Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) but also in all the different learning areas. Likewise, such values can also be incorporated in the activities of the different celebrations of the month, such as the:
 - a. National Children's Month,
 - b. Economic and Financial Literacy Week,
 - c. Global Warming and Climate Change Consciousness Week,
 - d. Araw ng Pagbasa,
 - e. National Week for the Gifted and Talented,
 - f. National Science and Technology Week, and
 - g. Other Co-curricular activities
- 4. All schools, in collaboration with other stakeholders, may create campaign and advocacy materials anchored on the theme to increase awareness among learners and the community.
- 5. Activities relative to the observance of the Filipino Values Month (FVM) shall preferably be in accordance with DepEd Order (DO) No. 9, s. 2005, Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged

Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and DO 34, s. 2022, School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023.

- 6. During the celebration, the minimum public health standards and Inter-Agency Task Force rulings shall be observed to prevent and minimize the spread of COVID- 19 in the community.
- 7. Activities conducted shall be posted on the Division FB page in EsP, Project U-SMART.
- 8. Photo documentation and narrative reports of the activities done during the month-long celebration must be submitted to the link which will be posted at the CID group chat on or before December 9, 2022. A Certificate of Accomplishment shall be given to schools that have complied the said report on time. No hard copies shall be submitted.
