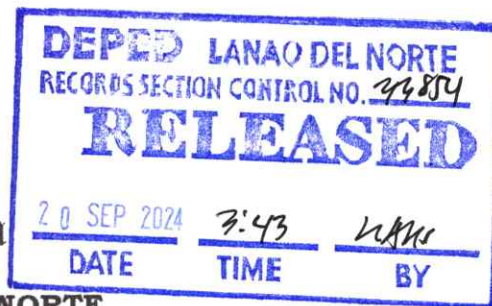

2. The activity aims to:

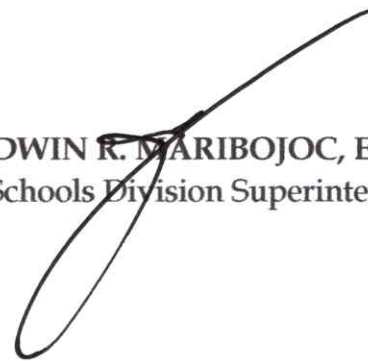
- a) **expand ALS enrollment:** Widen the coverage of the ALS program by actively identifying and enrolling out-of-school youths and adult learners, with a special focus on reaching remote, underserved, and marginalized communities.
- b) **enhance ALS learning delivery:** Implement blended learning approaches that integrate digital technologies, modular materials, and face-to-face sessions to cater to the diverse learning needs of ALS participants, ensuring an engaging and inclusive learning experience.
- c) **strengthen capacity building for ALS implementers:** Provide continuous professional development and training programs for ALS implementers to upgrade their teaching strategies, enhance their knowledge of the ALS K-12

Basic Education Curriculum, and improve their skills in addressing learner needs.

- d) **foster strategic partnerships:** Build and strengthen collaborations with local government units (LGUs), non-government organizations (NGOs), private sector partners, and community stakeholders to mobilize resources, support ALS initiatives, and ensure the sustainability and effectiveness of the program.
3. Allowable expenses to be incurred during the activity are chargeable against the school MOOE, local funds and other source of funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
