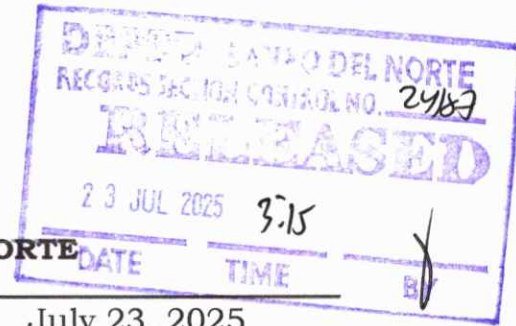

**ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) STRATEGIC PLANNING
AND DIRECTIONS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 2025-2026**

1. In accordance with the Department of Education's commitment to enhancing and expanding access to education through the Curriculum Implementation Division-Alternative Learning System (ALS), this Office announces the ALS strategic planning and directions for the school year 2025-2026 on July 24, 2025 8:00-5:00 PM at ALS Hub, Poblacion, Kapatagan, Lanao del Norte.
2. The objectives of the activity aim to:
 - a) **Expand ALS Enrollment:** Widen the coverage of the ALS program by actively identifying and enrolling out-of-school youths and adult learners, with a special focus on reaching remote, underserved, and marginalized communities.
 - b) **Enhance ALS Learning Delivery:** Implement blended learning approaches that integrate digital technologies, modular materials, and face-to-face sessions to cater to the diverse learning needs of ALS participants, ensuring an engaging and inclusive learning experience.
 - c) **Strengthen Capacity Building for ALS Implementers:** Provide continuous professional development and training programs for ALS implementers to upgrade their teaching strategies, enhance their knowledge of the ALS K-12 Basic Education Curriculum, and improve their skills in addressing learner needs.
 - d) **Foster Strategic Partnerships:** Build and strengthen collaborations with local government units (LGUs), non-government organizations (NGOs), private sector partners, and community stakeholders to



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mobilize resources, support ALS initiatives, and ensure the sustainability and effectiveness of the program.

3. Allowable expenses to be incurred during the activity are chargeable against the school MOOE, local funds and other source of funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Participants are ALS Focal, Education Program Specialists II and Municipal Focal Persons.
5. All participants are requested to bring their own baon or "Bring Your Own Provision" (BYOP) for lunch and snacks during the activity. This is to ensure practicality and convenience for all participants while maintaining health and safety protocols.
