MEMORANDUM

CONDUCT OF SCHOOL CANTEEN INSPECTION IN PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF KAPATAGAN

1. This Office informs all concerned personnel that the Municipal Health Office (MHO) of Kapatagan will conduct inspections of school canteens in all public elementary and secondary schools within the Municipality of Kapatagan during the month of June 2026.
2. The activity aims to ensure compliance with existing health, sanitation, and food safety standards prescribed under applicable laws, rules, and regulations. The inspection shall focus on food preparation, handling, storage, sanitation practices, and overall canteen operations to safeguard the health and well-being of learners, teaching personnel, and non-teaching staff.
3. In view thereof, all school heads are directed to coordinate closely with the Municipal Health Office inspection team and extend the necessary assistance and cooperation during the conduct of the inspection. They are likewise requested to ensure that all pertinent documents, permits, and records related to canteen operations are readily available for verification.
4. To minimize disruption to classes, teaching-learning activities, and other school operations, school heads shall coordinate with the inspection team regarding the schedule and conduct of the inspection.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.


Please be advised that inspections may be conducted at reasonable times within the specified period, in accordance with the authority granted under P.D. 856.
