## SUBJECT: CONDUCT OF VIRTUAL READING FESTIVAL for SY 2021 – 2022

- 1. This is to inform the field of the conduct of Reading Festival on May 25, 2022 for school year 2021-2022.
- 2. This activity aims to develop positive self-perception of our Grade II learners who have shown commendable performance in reading after the intervention conducted.
- 3. Participants of the Reading Festival are the Grade II struggling readers indicated in the list submitted to this Office through the district ELLN Coordinator.
- 4. The events to be contested are spelling and reading comprehension.
- 5. Attached are the general guidelines and contest mechanics for your references.
- 6. Widest dissemination of this Memorandum is highly enjoined.

### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- 1. Each district shall conduct its own competition to select the contestants in all categories.
- 2. Participants to this competition are presently enrolled Grade II learners. A contestant is allowed to participate in one category only.
- Only District 1<sup>st</sup> place winners per category are qualified to join the contest in the Division Level. In case the 1<sup>st</sup> place winner is unable to participate, the 2<sup>nd</sup> placer may represent the district.
- 4. Participants of the different contest categories are encouraged to wear their school uniform during the contest. However, this is not compulsory.
- 5. STRICTLY NO COACHING SHALL BE OBSERVED WHILE THE CONTEST/PRESENTATION IS GOING ON.
- 6. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category is to be followed strictly. The judges will agree on the deductions to be given for every violation on the mechanics of the contest.
- 7. All winners will receive medals and certificates of recognition while the non-winners will be given certificates of participation.
- 8. The panel of judges shall be composed of a chairman and two members.
- 9. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.
- 10. Entry Form per district will be submitted to the Division Office through a Google drive on May 23, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. following this format.

## **CONTEST MECHANICS**

# A. SPELLING

- 1. **Spelling** contest will be participated in by the Grade II learners composing a team of three.
- One team for each category English, Filipino, Sinugbuanong Binisaya and Meranaw).
- 3. The contest shall be conducted online.
- 4. There will be 10 words for easy round (Elimination Round) with 15 seconds each word and with1 point each correct answer.
- 5. Only those who will score 7points and up in the easy round will proceed to the average round. For the average round, there will be 10 phrases (composed of 2 words each) with 2 points each correct answer for 30 seconds each.
- 6. For the difficult round, there will be 5 sentences with 5 points each correct answer for 1 minute each.
- 7. All contestants should wear headphones, with open microphone during the contest and with cameras showing the back and front areas of the contestant or with mirror at the back area.

# B. READING COMPREHENSION

- 1. Reading Comprehension contest will be participated in by the Grade II learners.
- 2. One participant for each category English, Filipino, Sinugbuanong Binisaya, Meranaw.
- 3. Each participant is given a selection to read for 5 minutes. After the reading time, the participant shall read the selection orally.
- 4. After the oral reading, the learner is given 5 minutes to answer the 10-item test.
- 5. The learner with the highest score both in word recognition and reading comprehension shall be declared the winner.
