CONVERSION AND RECLASSIFICATION OF EXISTING GUIDANCE COUNSELOR AND GUIDANCE COORDINATOR POSITIONS PURSUANT TO RA 12080

All Others Concerned

1. In reference to **DepEd Memorandum DM-OUHROD-2026-0135**, and pursuant to **Republic Act No. 12080**, all **incumbent Guidance Counselors and Guidance Coordinators** in this Division are hereby directed to submit the mandatory application requirements for the conversion and reclassification of their existing positions.
2. Accordingly, all concerned personnel are directed to refer to Attachment A: Mandatory Application Requirements and shall submit the complete and correct documentary requirements to the **Personnel Section** through the **Records Section on or before February 10, 2026**.
3. The submission of the said requirements is necessary to facilitate the proper evaluation, processing, and implementation of the conversion and reclassification of positions in accordance with existing laws, rules, and regulations.
4. Failure to submit the required documents, or submission of incomplete requirements within the prescribed period, shall result in the deferment of processing of the concerned position.

IMPORTANT NOTE:
For PDS: Applicant must ensure all details and information are correct and updated from page 1-4.
For WES: applicant must include previous and current work experience, accomplishments, and detailed job functions and duties. These experiences must be reflected and must be consistent with your accomplished PDS.

 GUIDANCE COUNSELOR AND GUIDANCE
 COORDINATOR POSITIONS PURSUANT TO RA 12080

DATE : 22 January 2026

The Republic Act No. 12080, s. 2024, otherwise known as the *Basic Education Mental Health and Well-Being Promotion Act*, reinforces the promotion and delivery of mental health and psychosocial support services across the basic education system. Section 2 of RA 12080 specifically states that the law aims to:

“strengthen the existing mental health and guidance and counseling program and other health and wellness activities, including sports-related programs, through the development of an effective and efficient school-based mental health program, to promote and ensure the mental health and well-being of all learners, as well as provide mental health awareness and literacy programs and appropriate mental health-related referrals to the teaching and non-teaching personnel, in all public and private basic education schools in the country.”

To this end, the Law mandates the establishment of Mental Health and Well-Being Office (MHWBO) in all Schools Division Offices (SDO) and Care Centers in every public school to be operated by competent personnel, ensuring that learners and personnel have access to appropriate mental health support.

To operationalize these provisions, the Act further provides under Section 9 the creation of new plantilla positions within the Department of Education (DepEd), as follows:

Under the same section, the Act mandates that the positions of Guidance Counselor and Guidance Coordinator shall be **converted or reclassified** to the appropriate newly created positions, subject to the eligibility and qualifications set by the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), Civil Service Commission (CSC), and DepEd in accordance with the provisions of the Law.

In view of the above, the Bureau of Human Resource and Organizational Development (BHROD), in coordination with the DBM, shall facilitate the following:

1. **Conversion of existing vacant, dormant Guidance Counselor and Guidance Coordinator** positions to School Counselor Associate I (SCA I) (SG-11) positions through scrap-and-build process.

The BHROD has already identified 4,470 existing unfilled positions for conversion based on the GMIS data as of October 17, 2025. To ensure accuracy of the generated data, Human Resource Management Officers (HRMO) are directed to validate the status of the positions, whether filled or unfilled, through the following link:

Further, pending the DBM approval of the proposed conversion of vacant positions, all SDOs are directed to **suspend the filling-up of the Guidance Counselor and Guidance Coordinator positions**. A separate Memorandum shall be issued once the conversion to SCA I positions is approved.

2. Reclassification (or retitling¹) of existing *filled* positions to appropriate new position titles, subject to the qualification of the incumbent vis-à-vis the Qualification Standards (QS) as approved by the CSC.

With the intent to submit an indicative list of positions for reclassification (or retitling) and its corresponding funding requirements, Regional Offices (RO) and SDOs are directed to conduct initial evaluation of incumbents based on the proposed QS, pending its CSC approval; and submit the list and corresponding Personnel Services (PS) requirement using the existing Plantilla Allocation List (PAL) format.

¹ A form of reclassification of position that does not involve change in salary grade

Guidelines for the Regional and Schools Division Offices

A. Schools Division Offices (SDOs)

1. Require all incumbent Guidance Counselors and Guidance Coordinators to prepare and submit to the Human Resource Management Officer (HRMO) on or before the deadline to be set by the SDO the mandatory application requirements consistent with Section 20 of DepEd Order (DO) No. 007, s. 2023, titled *Guidelines on the Recruitment, Selection, and Appointment in the Department of Education*:
 - Letter of intent addressed to the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS);
 - Duly accomplished Personal Data sheet (PDS) (*CSC Form 212, Revised 2025*) with Work Experience Sheet;
 - Photocopy of valid and updated PRC License/ID, if available;
 - Certificate of Certificate of Eligibility/Rating, if available;
 - Photocopy of scholastic/academic record (i.e., Special Orders, Transcript of Records (TOR), and Diploma, including completion of graduate and post-graduate units/degrees, if available);
 - Photocopy of duly signed Service Record;
 - Photocopy of certificate/s of relevant training;
 - Photocopy of the Performance Rating in the last rating period covering one (1) complete performance cycle in the current position; and
 - Checklist of Requirements and Omnibus Sworn Statement on the Certification on the Authenticity and Veracity (CAV) of the documents submitted and Data Privacy Consent Form pursuant to RA No. 10173 (*Data Privacy Act of 2012*).
2. Evaluate the qualifications of the incumbents and determine the appropriate position to which they are qualified based on the proposed QS (*Please see **Annex A: Proposed Qualification Standards for School Counselor and School Counselor Associate Positions***).
3. In the process of evaluation, the following shall likewise be observed:
 - Only licensed Registered Guidance Counselors (RGCs) and Registered Psychologists (RPsy) may be qualified for reclassification or retitling to the appropriate School Counselor (SC) position; and
 - Non-RGCs and Non-RPsy incumbents shall be reclassified or retitled to the appropriate SCA position.
4. Prepare a summary of the assessment using the existing Initial Evaluation Results (IER). The IER for each position shall contain all the applicants who were deemed qualified for the particular position.
5. Based on the duly signed IER, prepare and submit to the ROs a duly signed Position Allocation List (PAL) using the attached template in **Annex B** on or before **February 20, 2026**.

B. Regional Offices (ROs)

1. RO HRMO shall consolidate and validate all submissions from SDOs to ensure accuracy and completeness of the documents, for onward approval and signature of the Regional Director.
2. Upon approval, submit the consolidated, duly signed PAL to the BHROD-Organization Effectiveness Division at bhrod.oed@deped.gov.ph on or before **February 27, 2026**, for onward submission to DBM Central Office.
3. Once the nationally-consolidated PAL has been approved by the DBM, the DBM RO shall process and issue the Notices of Organization Staffing and Compensation Action (NOSCA) to the DepEd RO counterpart, copy furnished the respective SDOs, for subsequent processing of the appointment papers.
