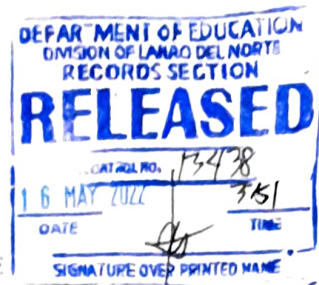

1. In view of the conduct of the Reading Festival for SY 2021-2022 on May 25, 2022, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, hereby informs the field of the venues, mechanics of the contests and the criteria for judging.
2. Contests will be held in the following venues:
English Category and MTB-MLE Category - Tubod Central Elem. Sch.
Filipino Category - Rufo dela Cruz IS
3. Participants shall be in the venue before 8:00 in the morning for the opening program to be facilitated by the assigned Education Program Supervisors.
4. Attached are the Contest Mechanics and the Criteria for Judging for reference.
5. Wearing of face masks, proper hand washing and social distancing shall be observed during the entire competition.
6. Travel, meals and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to the school's MOOE and other funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. All other provisions indicated in the previous memorandum shall remain in force.

CONTEST MECHANICS

A. SPELLING

1. **Spelling** contest will be participated in by the Grade II learners composing a team of three.
2. One team for each category - English, Filipino, Sinugbuanong Binisaya and Meranaw).
3. There will be 10 words for easy round (Elimination Round) with 15 seconds each word and with 1 point each correct answer.
4. Only those who will score 7 points and up in the easy round will proceed to the average round. For the average round, there will be 10 phrases (composed of 2 words each) with 2 points each correct answer for 30 seconds each.
5. For the difficult round, there will be 5 sentences with 5 points each correct answer for 1 minute each.

C. READING COMPREHENSION

1. **Reading Comprehension** contest will be participated in by the Grade II learners.
2. One participant for each category - English, Filipino, Sinugbuanong Binisaya, Meranaw.

For the English Category:

1. The coach shall have an active MS Teams Account in Office 365 (not the browser).
2. The ICT Assistant shall create a classroom in MS Teams. The members are the coaches since the participants have no MS Teams accounts yet.
3. **For word recognition**, each participant is given a selection to read for 5 minutes
4. After 5 minutes, the participant shall read the selection orally using the MS Teams Reading Progress Application.
5. After reading, the coach shall TURN IN the video of the participant for scoring purposes.
6. **For the reading comprehension**, the participant is given 2 minutes to reread the selection.
7. He shall answer the questions with multiple choice using tag boards (1/2 size illustration board) after the contest facilitator reads the questions.
8. The participant with the highest score shall be declared the winner.

For the Filipino, Sinugbuanong Binisaya and Meranaw Categories:

1. Each participant is given a selection to read for 5 minutes.
2. After 5 minutes, the participant shall read the selection orally.
3. During the oral reading, judges shall take note of the miscues such as *mispronunciation, omissions, reversals and insertions*.
4. After reading the selection, the participant shall answer the questions with multiple choice using the tag board (1/2 size illustration board) after the contest facilitator reads the questions.
5. The participant with the highest score shall be declared the winner.

**Criteria for the Reading Contest in Filipino, Sinugbuanong Binisaya,
and Meranaw**

Criterion	Weight
1. Speed (No. of Words/Time Spent)	20%
2. Accuracy (No. of Words less mispronunciation, omissions, reversals and insertions)	30%
3. Comprehension	50%
Total	100%

Criteria for the Reading Contest in English

Criterion	Weight
1. Correct Words per Minute	20%
2. Accuracy	30%
3. Comprehension	50%
Total	100%
