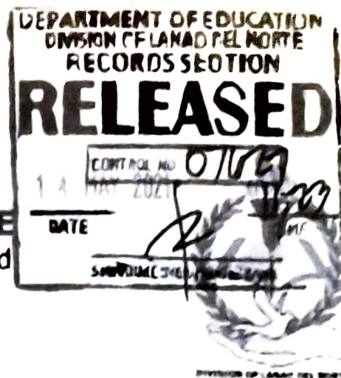

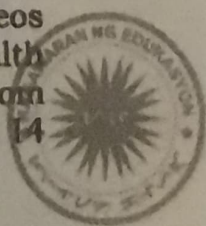

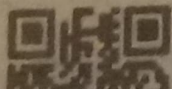
In this regard, the OUA reiterates the following information about the GMC, which was first disseminated through OUA Memorandum 00-0521-0036:

1. HealthJustice Philippines, on behalf of the GGTC, is inviting **DepEd learners, personnel, and stakeholders** to join the second GMC with the theme **Lies & Cover-Ups: Time to Make Tobacco Pay**.
2. The competition aims to welcome graphic material submissions as memes, GIFs, digital stickers, posters, infographics, and short videos that portray tobacco industry manipulation which undermines health policies and helps the tobacco industry escape liability from enormous burdens it has caused. Submissions can be made until **14 May 2021**.



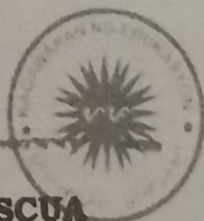
