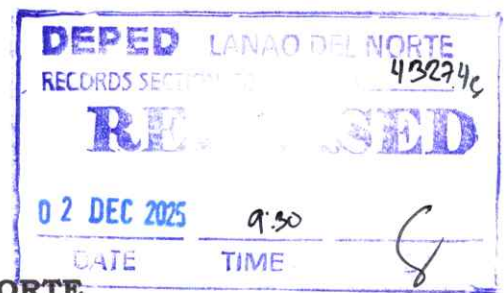

1. This issuance refers to the Regional Memorandum No. 960, s. 2025, titled DepEd-TESDA Convergence on the Implementation of Quality Assured Assessment for the National Certification of Learners in Senior High School Technical Vocational Livelihood Track and Expansion of the Number of Competency Assessors in Compliance to DepEd Order 3, s. 2025.
