The Office of the Undersecretary for Operations, through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS), hereby informs all concerned on the rescheduling of the conduct of the **1st Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill for CY 2024** from March 14, 2024, 9:00 AM to **March 25, 2024, 9:00 AM**. The said change of schedule is in accordance to the NDRRMC Memorandum No. 020, s. 2024, as attached.

Concurrently, regarding the implementation of DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2024, amending the DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2023 as to the "Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024" and ensure non-disruption of the 3rd Quarter Examinations on March 25-26, 2024, it is recommended to conduct the 1st Quarter NSED of schools on **March 22, 2024, or March 27, 2024**. The rest of the CY 2024 schedules are retained on their original dates unless otherwise amended.

For the submission of NSED reports, the Regional DRRM Coordinators are required to consolidate all NSED reports and photo documentation, and submit to the DRRMS via email at drmo@deped.gov.ph copy furnished to their respective Regional Directors, **not later than fifteen (15) working days after the schedule of the quarterly NSED**. For the 1st Quarter NSED, Regional Coordinators are to submit their consolidated Regional NSED Reports **on or before 22 April 2024, 05:00 PM**.

Pursuant to the approved NDRRMC Memorandum No. 013, s. 2024 "Conduct of the CY 2024 Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill", offices across all levels of the Department and schools are enjoined to participate in the conduct of quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) with schedule as follows:

Quarter	Date	Time
1 st Quarter	March 14, 2024	09:00 AM
2 nd Quarter	June 13, 2024	02:00 PM
3 rd Quarter	September 12, 2024	09:00 AM
4 th Quarter	November 14, 2024	02:00 PM

Additionally, NDRRMC Memorandum No. 06, s. 2023 allowed the resumption of the conduct of traditional or in-person Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill since the beginning of the first quarter of 2023. It is therefore recommended to design and implement other forms of exercises based on needs assessment, aside from evacuation drills, to scale up overall earthquake preparedness. However, this is subject to the strict implementation of minimum health protocols such as but not limited to, social distancing and handwashing to ensure the safe and effective conduct of the NSED. All DepEd offices and schools responsible for implementing

the drill will assign Safety and Health Officers to monitor and evaluate the adherence to these protocols throughout the exercise.

To ensure awareness and preparedness on the impending threat of the inevitable occurrence of an earthquake, even amid pandemic, **Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) campaign in NSED using distant means should be continuously intensified.** A copy of NSED materials can be accessed through <http://tinyurl.com/DepEdNSED2024>.

In addition, **existing earthquake contingency plans of regional and division offices, and schools shall be updated** to incorporate mechanisms, and arrangements that are reflective of the current COVID-19 situation. To ensure minimum public health standards, the conduct of face-to-face NSED may be postponed or cancelled, or the methodology may be modified, if the IATF-EID decides to prohibit mass gatherings in any or all areas of the country due to certain circumstances.

For the post-NSED activities, the self-evaluation and processing of the NSED within respective areas of jurisdiction are encouraged after the conduct of NSED. The Office of Civil Defense (OCD) Exercise Evaluation Guide (EEG) can be used as a guide. The EEG can be accessed on the above link.

Proper documentation and post-activity evaluation of said drill are required. All field offices are advised to make necessary preparations to ensure that the required reports are submitted on time, as indicated in Annex A. Also attached is the NDRRMC Memorandum No. 013, s. 2024 for reference.

ANNEX A

Guidelines on the Quarterly Submission of the 2024 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drills (NSED) Report

All DepEd Regional Offices, Schools Division Offices, and schools should thoroughly follow the guidelines below:

For Schools

1. The School DRRM Coordinator shall accomplish the Monitoring and Reporting Template (**Annex B**), to be signed by corresponding School DRRM Coordinator and School Head.
2. Guidelines on the photo and video documentation are in **Annex C**.
3. The signed form with attached photo and video documentation of NSED practices and initiatives shall be submitted to the respective Division DRRM Coordinators **not later than five (5) working days, after the schedule of the quarterly NSED**.

For Schools Division Offices

1. The Division DRRM Coordinators must consolidate NSED reports and pictures from School DRRM Coordinators.
2. Consolidated NSED reports and pictures must be submitted by the Division DRRM Coordinators **only to respective Regional DRRM Coordinators** copy furnished their respective Schools Division Superintendent **not later than ten (10) working days, after the schedule of the quarterly NSED**.
3. The Division DRRM Coordinators shall keep a copy of the submitted report for future reference, as necessary.

For Regional Coordinators

1. The Regional DRRM Coordinators must consolidate NSED reports and pictures from Division DRRM Coordinators.
2. Consolidated NSED reports and pictures must be submitted by the Regional DRRM Coordinators to the **DRRMS** via email drmo@deped.gov.ph copy furnished their respective Regional Directors **not later than fifteen (15) working days, after the schedule of the quarterly NSED**. Refer to the following table for the schedule of submission of the quarterly regional NSED report:

3. Regional DRRM Coordinators are requested to submit at least **five (5) best pictures** from their respective regions. Soft copies are to be attached to their report.
4. Regional DRRM Coordinators should use the naming convention below as subject line for emails:

The cut-off time for all deadlines will be at 05:00 PM. The official number of schools participating in the NSED will be based on the consolidated NSED report signed by the Regional Director or authorized official from the regional office to be submitted to DRRMS.

The DRRMS shall submit the national consolidated report to the Office of the Civil Defense through the Office of the Undersecretary for Operations.

ANNEX C

Guidelines on the Photo and Video Documentation of Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill

The following guidelines is set for the photo and video documentation of the quarterly conduct of NSED in schools and DepEd offices:

1. Photo and video recordings of quarterly NSED conduct may be used in information and communication materials of the Department, as requested.
2. All materials should display adherence to minimum health protocols such as but not limited to, social distancing and wearing of face masks.
3. The following scenarios must be included in the documentation of the school:
 - a. Learners, personnel, and/or parents/guardians wearing personal protective equipment such as hard hats.
 - b. Learners, personnel, and/or parents/guardians doing the Duck, Cover, and Hold.
 - c. Conduct of coordination/preparatory meeting.
 - d. Actual conduct of the quarterly NSED.
4. The recommended minimum specifications are as follows:
 - a. Photo
 - i. File format: JPG or PNG
 - ii. Dimensions: 4:3 ratio or 16:9 ratio
 - iii. Orientation: Landscape
 - b. Video
 - i. File format: MP4 or MOV (with 1080p or 720p resolution)
 - ii. Dimensions: 1920px x 1080px (16:9)
 - iii. Orientation: Landscape
 - iv. Frame rate: 30fps or 60fps

SUBJECT: Conduct of the CY 2024 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill

Rule 6, Section 7 of the Implementing Rules and Regulation of the RA 10121 states that "Public awareness shall also be undertaken through the conduct of drills by the LDRRMO on a regular basis". Likewise, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan states that one of the activities to achieve Outcome 10: "Developed and implemented comprehensive national and local preparedness and response policies, plans, and systems" is also to develop/enhance and simulate scenario-based preparedness and response plans. Furthermore, one of the policy frameworks stated in the National Disaster Preparedness Plan as embedded in the fourth priority area of the Sendai Framework for Action 2015-2030 includes the target: to promote regular disaster preparedness, response and recovery exercises".

NDRRMC Memorandum No. 06 s. 2023 allowed the resumption of the conduct of traditional or in-person Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) beginning from the first quarter of 2023. It is therefore recommended that aside from evacuation drills, other forms of exercises may be designed and implemented based on needs assessment, to scale up the overall earthquake preparedness of your chosen sites.

In view thereof, the schedule for the CY 2024 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) and the Observance of the World Tsunami Awareness Day is hereby disseminated:

SUBJECT: Re-Scheduling of the First (1st) Quarter NSED 2024 and Amending for the Purpose NDRRMC Memorandum No. 013, s. 2024

NDRRMC Memorandum No. 013, s. 2024, dated 24 January 2024, provided for the schedules for the conduct of CY 2024 Quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED). Wherefore, pursuant to Section 09(i) of RA 10121, the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) is tasked to *establish Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Training Institutes in such suitable location as may be deemed appropriate to train public and private individuals, both local and national, in such subject as disaster risk reduction and management among others...*

Anent the said statutory provision, it has been part of the continuing agenda of the OCD, the NDRRMC, and of the DRRM practitioners to finally realize the establishment of the Institute. With this, in accordance with OCD Memorandum NO. 011, s. 2024, the Civil Defense Training Institute (CDTI) was reactivated and is set to be launched on **14 March 2024 (0900H)**, which will be attended by the NDRRMC member agencies, DRRM stakeholders, other partners, and the OCD Regional Offices representatives.


In view of the scheduled launching of the CDTI which coincides with the date of the First (1st) Quarter NSED, NDRRMC Memorandum No. 013, s. 2024 is **HEREBY AMENDED**. For which, the First (1st) Quarter NSED 2024 is therefore moved from 14 March 2024 (09:00 AM) to 25 March 2024 (09:00 AM).

The rest of the schedules are retained on their original dates, unless otherwise amended. Active participation of DRRMCs at all levels, including the Barangay DRRMCs, as well as the National Government Agencies and other Government entities is strongly encouraged.
