- 1. Please be advised that our Fourth Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) and observance of World Tsunami Awareness Day is scheduled on **November 5, 2018 at exactly 8:00a**m.

Schools in the coastal areas are required to integrate Tsunami Drill on their respective schools in order to increase awareness and knowledge on tsunami risk and establish tsunami early warning systems. The activity will test the coordination and communication mechanism during response operation.
