**DIVISION TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON ENHANCING EARLY LANGUAGE
AND NUMERACY SKILLS IN KINDERGARTEN**

1. In line with our commitment to fostering the holistic development of our young learners, this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, shall conduct a 3-day training-workshop on **"Enhancing Early Language and Numeracy Skills in Kindergarten"** designed to strengthen the capacity of kindergarten teachers to deliver developmentally appropriate, engaging, and inclusive instruction aligned with the Philippine Kindergarten Curriculum Framework. Recognizing that early literacy and numeracy lay the foundation for lifelong learning, this workshop responds to observed gaps in emergent reading, oral language proficiency, print awareness, number sense, and problem-solving skills among young learners, as reflected in classroom observations and early childhood assessment results. The training-workshop shall be conducted on **October 28-30, 2025 at Horizon Resort Splashaway, Baroy, Lanao del Norte.**

2. The activity aims to:

- enhance teachers' knowledge and application of developmentally appropriate, inclusive, and play-based strategies for teaching early literacy and numeracy in alignment with the Revised K to 10 Curriculum for Kindergarten.
- equip teachers with effective assessment tools and techniques for monitoring and supporting children's progress in oral language, pre-reading, writing readiness, and number concepts.
- develop contextualized learning activities that integrate literacy and numeracy across learning domains while promoting creativity, critical thinking, and learner engagement.
