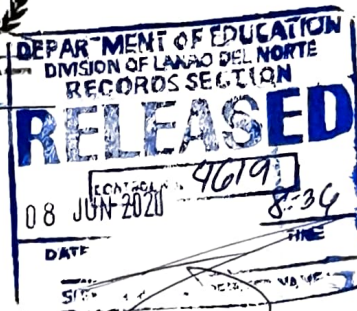




SUBJECT : DRRM ACTIVITIES TO BE UNDERTAKEN DURING
THE 2020 *BRIGADA ESKWELA* AND *OPLAN BALIK*
ESKWELA RELATIVE TO THE COVID-19 SITUATION

DATE : June 2, 2020

1. Relative to *Deped Memorandum No. 053 series of 2020*, this year's *Brigada Eskwela* aims to support in the provision of different learning opportunities while ensuring the health and safety of our learners and personnel.
2. This office advises all School Heads to undertake the following DRRM activities and initiatives aside from the usual activities regularly conducted during the past *Brigada Eskwela*.
 - a. Coordinate with the Local Government Unit or the Municipal DRRMO for the disinfection of school buildings, classrooms and other school facilities.
 - b. Ensure that the items listed in **Annex A** of this Memorandum are raised during the conduct of *Brigada Eskwela* with the help of our partners.
 - c. Ensure that psychological first aid or other psychological interventions and debriefing are conducted in the support of different stakeholders.
3. The field is further advised to Submit a brief Narrative Report of the School Disinfection with the following information and email it to danieljr.deluna@deped.gov.ph not later than **August 29, 2020**.
 - 2 to 3 photos
 - Date of Disinfection
 - Source of Fund (LGU/Barangay, MOOE, Private Donors, Personal)
4. Immediate dissemination and strict compliance of this Memorandum is desired.

- 1. Thermal scanners**
- 2. Hand sanitizing materials, such as rubbing alcohol, anti-bacterial, or germicidal soap.**
- 3. Cleaning tools, materials or disinfectants that may use to disinfect learning areas, such as spray tank, disinfectant spray, or disinfecting bleach, foot bath.**
- 4. Washable face mask, surgical face mask, face shield, and surgical gloves.**
- 5. Multivitamins capsules, tablets, or syrups for Deped personnel and learners.**
- 6. Printing of COVID-19 and sanitation / proper hand washing hygiene information materials; and**
- 7. Printing of materials and provision of supplies for distance learning for the learners, teachers and parents (i.e. bond papers, worksheets, notebooks, pad paper, ball pens, pencils, crayons, coloring materials, and others)**
