



1. In preparation of the Northern Mindanao Athletic Association Meet this December, the Division of Lanao del Norte will hold the annual search for Miss LDNAA 2019 and Hip-Hop Competition on October 17, 2019 at Baroy Central Elementary School, Baroy, Lanao del Norte.
2. There will be a screening of candidates on the following dates:
 - o September 26, 2019 at 8 A.M. for REGION 1 (Kolambugan to Baloi) at Maigo National High School, Maigo, Lanao del Norte
 - o September 27, 2019 at 8 A.M. for REGION 2 (Tubod to SND) at Lala National High School, Maranding, Lala National High School

Pageant Guidelines

1. The beauty pageant will be on October 17, 2019 at Baroy Central Elementary School, Baroy, Lanao del Norte.
2. The candidate must be good looking with pleasing personality and must stand at least 5'4 inches tall.
3. The pageant is open to all public and private junior or senior high school students who are currently enrolled in this school year, 2019-2020 of the school they are representing.
4. She must be officially endorsed by the school principal through a certification duly authenticated by the principal. Submission of endorsements will be on the following screening days:
September 26, 2019 8AM for REGION 1 (Kolambugan to Baloi) at Maigo National High School
September 27, 2019 8AM for REGION 2 (SND to Tubod) at Lala National High School
Candidates for screening must come in casual attire and appropriate foot wear.
5. Candidates who passed the screening are expected to be in Baroy Central Elementary School for a whole day practice on October 16, 2019. They must bring the following during the practice:
 - a. Duly filled out entry form with 3x5 inches head shot photo and 3x5 inches full shot photo with light make-up.
 - b. At least 5 inches high-heeled sandal.
6. The official candidates will undergo 4 categories of the competition namely; **Production Number and Attire (White Apparel), Sports Wear, Evening Gown and Question and Answer Round.**
7. All these four categories will follow the ranking scheme which means the candidates will be ranked according to the criteria set by the management which determine the five finalists who will undergo the final Q and A to determine the winners to wit; MISS LDNAA 2019, 1st Runner Up, 2nd Runner Up, 3rd Runner Up, and 4th Runner Up. The Miss LDNAA 2019 will represent the division of Lanao del Norte in the Search for Ms. NMRAA 2019 this December, 2019.
8. The candidates will also get the chance to receive the following awards:
 - a. Best in Production Number and Best in Production Attire (White Apparel)
 - b. Best in Sports Wear
 - c. Best in Evening Gown
 - d. Miss Photogenic
 - e. Miss Cooperative
 - f. Miss Congeniality
9. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

HIPHOP COMPETITION 2019

Hip-hop Dance Defined

There is no one definition to describe hip-hop dance. Hip-hop dance is a fusion of street dance disciplines and cultural interpretations from around the world. A hip-hop dance routine incorporates the look, music, attitude, posture, and street dance style to make it uniquely hip-hop. The routines shall showcase a variety of hip-hop dance styles, signature moves, and choreography conveying the character and energy of the street.

Contest Guidelines

1. The hip-hop competition will be on October 17, 2019 at Baroy Central Elementary School, Baroy, Lanao del Norte.
2. The competition is open to junior or senior high school students and are currently enrolled in this school year, 2019-2020 of the school they are representing.
3. Crew is composed of 8-10 dancers, either all-male, all-female, or a combination of both. They will choreograph a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 5 minutes hip-hop dance routine.
4. Any movement that risks injury to a crew member is highly discouraged. All moves and especially 'tricks' must be executed with assistance of a co-dancer from floor to aerial to dismount. Violation of this rule will mean 5-point deduction from the general average score of the crew.
5. Lewd or offensive music and costumes will also incur a 2-point deduction from the general average score of the crew.
6. Crews must be officially endorsed by the school principal through a certification duly authenticated by the school principal. Deadline of submission of endorsement will be on October 14, 2019 to be passed at the SGOD Office, Division of Lanao del Norte. Crews are expected to be in Baroy Central Elementary School for a half day blocking on October 16, 2019 at 1pm. Crews who would like to stay for the night at Baroy Central Elementary School must inform the organizing committee and contact Mr. Jovanny M. Pangasian through cellphone no. 09260151475.
7. Crews must bring their music in CD and USB files during the practice.
8. The top three crews will be awarded with cash prizes and will perform during the events in the NMRAA MEET 2019 in December this year.
9. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
