

**Mechanisms for the Integration of Displaced Teachers
and Learners from the Divisions of Marawi City and Lanao del Sur
to Public Schools Within DepEd-Region 10**

Pursuant to the mandate of the Regional Office on the supervision and management of school within its jurisdiction, the following shall serve as the mechanism to be strictly observed in the Integration of Displaced Teachers and Learners from the affected areas of the Marawi City insurgency:

1. Deployment of Displaced teachers.

Displaced teachers shall:

- a. secure Deployment Order duly signed by the DepEd-ARMM Secretary and present the same to the receiving Schools Division Superintendent in Region X where they will be assigned;
- b. obtain Notice of Assignment from the receiving Schools Division Office for proper deployment to the receiving school;
- c. present Notice of Assignment to the receiving School Head where assigned;
- d. secure Certificate of First Day of Service from the receiving School Head; and
- e. furnish the SDS a copy of the Certificate of First Day of Service.

2. Instructional Supervision of Deployed teachers.

Deployed teachers shall be:

- a. managed and supervised by the receiving School Head in accordance with the existing laws, rules and regulations;
- b. assigned to public school preferably to classes with more number of Maranao learners;
- c. given assignment/teaching loads based specialization/competency
- d. strictly prohibited to hold classes of displaced learners outside of DepEd schools;
- e. pulled out from their classes/school only upon approval of the receiving Schools Division Superintendent;
- f. supported with the regular and necessary capacity building for teachers; and
- g. provided with a continuing mental and psychosocial health interventions.

3. Management of Displaced Learners.

Displaced learners shall be:

- a. integrated to appropriate regular classes of the receiving school;
- b. organized as one class when the number warrants the creation of such following the teacher-learner ratio of 1:45;

- c. pulled out from their classes only upon the approval of the school head; and
- d. provided with a continuing mental and psychosocial health intervention.

4. Operation of Affected Private Schools.

Private Schools in Marawi City and Lanao del Sur operating within the jurisdiction of the DepEd-Region 10 shall adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 88, s. 2010 entitled "*2010 Revised Manual of Regulations for Private Schools in Basic Education*"

This mechanism shall remain effective until revoked by the issuing authority.
