1. The School Governance and Operations Division, through the Special Programs and Projects Section, shall conduct an **Orientation on D.O. 006, s. 2026 and Revisiting D.O. 40, s. 2012 and D.O. 55, s. 2013** on September 8 (Region 1) & September 9, 2026 (Region 2) at Evergreen Garden's, Esperanza, Bacolod, Lanao del Norte.
2. The activity aims to address the following:
 - a. Refresh and deepen participants' understanding of key concepts, principles, and provisions of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012, DepEd Order 55, s. 2013 and DepEd Order 006, s. 2026.
 - b. Clarify the roles, responsibilities, and accountability mechanisms of Child Protection Committee members and personnel (both women and men) in advancing child protection initiatives within the schools.
 - c. Revisit current CP Policy, tools, and practices to identify gaps, challenges, and best practices in gender in planning, implementation, and monitoring of education programs.
 - d. Promote active participation and collaboration among women and men personnel in implementing child protection and anti-bullying policies, ensuring that gender equality is addressed collectively.

3. The participants to this activity are all the Chairpersons of the Child Protection Committee (School Heads) or the Vice Chairpersons (School Guidance Counselor Designates).

4. Registration Fee of Php 750.00 (Food of the participants), Travelling and other incidental expenses incurred during the above activity shall be charged to local/MOOE funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
