**PARTICIPATION OF SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL AND ALTERNATIVE LEARNING
SYSTEM (ALS) LEARNERS IN THE DTI-RAPID GROWTH PROJECT
"BUSINESS EXPENSES AND SAVINGS TRAINING THROUGH GAME
(BEST GAME)"**

1. In support of the Department of Education's commitment to strengthening youth entrepreneurship and financial literacy, and pursuant to the request of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) – Lanao del Norte under the RAPID Growth Project, this Office enjoins the participation of identified learners in the Business Expenses and Savings Training through Game (BEST Game).

2. The BEST Game is a one-day experiential business simulation designed to equip participants with practical entrepreneurial knowledge, financial management skills, and decision-making competencies through interactive gameplay. The activity also aims to encourage greater youth participation in the banana, cacao, coconut, and coffee value chains within the province.

3. The training is intended for Senior High School and Alternative Learning System (ALS) learners aged 18–35 years, preferably those residing in DTI-RAPID Growth Project-covered areas and those with interests or involvement in entrepreneurship, agribusiness, production, processing, or marketing of agricultural commodities.

4. School Heads of the identified schools are requested to:

- identify and endorse thirty (30) participants, composed of fifteen (15) male and fifteen (15) female learners;
- give priority to qualified Senior High School and ALS learners who meet the target participant profile;

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- c. designate a school focal person to coordinate with the DTI-RAPID Growth Project Team regarding the activity;
- d. provide, when necessary, an appropriate classroom or school facility as the venue for the training; and
- e. submit the official list of participants **on or before July 24, 2026**, to facilitate the preparation of certificates and other logistical requirements.

5. DTI-RAPID Growth Project shall provide the resource persons, training materials, meals, and snacks for all participants.

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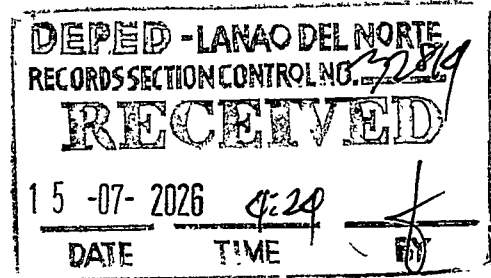

Greetings of peace!

We sincerely appreciate your invaluable support in implementing our youth intervention programs in the Province of Lanao del Norte, particularly in endorsing and identifying Senior High School and Alternative Learning System (ALS) learners to participate in our activities.

Furthermore, the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) – Lanao del Norte, through the RAPID Growth Project, will conduct the “Business Expenses and Savings Training – through Game” (BEST Game) from July 28 to September 9, 2026, in various schools and barangays across Lanao del Norte. 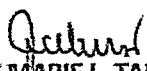
