- 1. Per DepEd Order No. 44, s. 2015 titled Guidelines on the Enhanced School Improvement Planning (SIP) Process and the School Report Card (SRC), this Office hereby directs all schools to submit the School Report Card (SRC) for SY 2021-2022 composed of 19 parts clearly defined in Enclosure No.1 of this Memorandum as a guide. Authorized persons who will validate and certify the accuracy of the reported data must be reflected at the last page of the SRC. See Enclosure No. 2 for the authorized signatures.
- 2. Elementary and Secondary School Heads must submit hard copies of the School Report Card for SY 2021-2022. Below is the schedule of submission:

- 3. School Heads are advised to submit and endorse the SRCs to the Division Office by District/Municipality and should follow strictly the deadline given.
- 4. Once the SRC is approved, school heads should disseminate the SRC during the recognition/graduation ceremony or to the public by posting it on the school bulletin boards or the school's website and other means of dissemination provided that minimum health protocols should be observed.
- Monitoring on the SRC dissemination shall be done by the School Governance Operation Division (SGOD). Please refer to Enclosure No. 1 for the SRC checklist.
- 6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.
