The topics to be discussed in the Presidential Election forum and Campus-Wide Presidential and Vice-Presidential Debates shall be those deemed relevant to the current situation of the student body and shall, likewise, showcase the candidate's capacities as student leaders. The topics and guidelines for these two events shall be determined by the COMELEC in each school.
